ADOPTION OF MINUTES

The meeting was called to order with the following members present: Paula Cormier, Julie Moore and Special guest Mike Cormier, however quorum was not met so the minutes could not be adopted.

Mike Cormier has expressed interest in becoming a member of the Hilton Beach Recreation Committee. He has presented a letter to council requesting his hope that he be accepted into the Hilton Beach Recreation Committee.

HILTON FAMILY YARD SALE-JUNE 24, 2017

Julie mentioned putting a small classified in the Island Clipping saying “Save the Date” and information about the registration forms for the June 5th and 12th edition, and put a larger ad for the June 19th edition. We would also use the same dates for the Northshore Sentinel ads.

COMMUNITY NIGHT RECAP

Steve Ruitti had some concerns about the Pie Booth and its need for more signage. He felt that we should also get another banner made to be placed down on Marks St. indicating the location of the pie booth up at the hall. He would also like to see the price of the pie raised from 3.00 to 4.00. The Richards Landing Community Night sells theirs for 3.50, but that would not work with our tickets being a dollar. Mike Cormier mentioned that the Bingo did not do well this year, with only a handful of people in attendance. We will have to look at better signage and advertising. We will need to provide 24 dozen hotdogs and buns and at least 22 dozen sausages for CN 2017 since we ran out this year. Julie mentioned that the parade will need to get more organized with a parade kit in a tote that would include pens, a complete list reflecting all the categories and the breakdown in those categories and clip boards. We will need to purchase \$10,000 in tickets for 2017. Mike thinks we should move the Chair and Blanket away from the Dunking Tank and perhaps move the Fish Ponds and Plinko to that location. The Chair and Blanket would move to the vacant Fish Pond location. Debbie Shaughnessy ran the Basketball Toss this year and made mention that they had trouble with the Cork Shoot game next to them. Both booths are tethered together and when the basketballs hit the backstop, it knocked the ping pong balls off the tees, resulting in that volunteer having to pick up balls continually. We will have to look at separating the games and reinforcing the backs of both of the games. It was agreed

that we would like to see Ladder Golf replace the Golf game for next year. Ladder Golf is a game aimed at kids playing instead of adults. The Spiderman backpack could be given out as a prize for the ladder golf game. Dan See mentioned to one of the members that the committee should bring back the "old games". We will have to find out what he means by that. If it is Crown and Anchor, a lottery license will have to be obtained. Julie will look at having a fry truck come into Community Night. This will not interfere with the other food booths. Rental for such a spot would be \$250.00. The Sausage booth would like some shallow pans to put their cooked sausages on to keep warm and an inflatable pool for the pop and water. Paula will talk to Sally Cohen to see if her daughter would be interested in doing face painting and/or henna next year. Julie will talk to Valerie Adcock and Ian Murdock to see if they would like to be clowns in our 2017 CN and what the cost would be. Paula will look into balloons for a helium balloon canister.

OCTOBER 29 POTLUCK

The theme for this coming potluck is "Southern Comfort". Paula will create a poster for this event.

BIKE RACKS

Dave Moule has done a wonderful job creating the bike racks that have been distributed around the Village. We would like to thank him with a \$50.00 gift certificate to one of the local restaurants.
