Moule and they were positioned around the Village. Julie mentioned that Richards Landing has bike rentals also and we should find out from them what their waiver and rental fees involve. Julie and Mike said that they had a bike each to donate. Locks and chains would have to be purchased. Revenue from the bikes would go back into maintenance and service and any surplus could go to purchasing play equipment for the All Season Sports Surface and the Rink.

BIKE RACK STORAGE

Paula informed everyone that Tanya Alexander has put some of the racks at the workshop, while the one by the Waterfront Centre will be stored under the eaves. There is not enough storage space at the workshop to accommodate all the racks. Mike said that if the racks were painted with Tremclad paint, that they could be stored outside without any damage.
