Mr. Richards and Ms. Mattioli provided an overview of their plans for 2018, an overview of which is attached.

Some items discussed in greater detail include:

• API plans to prepare an all-inclusive agreement relating to streetlights and hydro poles as they relate to maintenance and liability. This will also include approval process for placement of banners, flowers, etc. on the poles. If approvals are required prior to the agreement, the request is to be forwarded to Dan Richards indicating which poles will be used and what is being placed on the poles.

It was noted that 2% of API poles are replaced annually. It was noted that there are double poles located on Marks Street. Mr. Richards will determine who owns the poles and if they do, they will remove the extra one.

They have completed a lot of work on the Island over the last couple of years and there are no plans for additional work this year.

It was confirmed that for tree trimming and removal, both the adjacent owners and the municipality are consulted prior to the work being done and regarding herbicide use. If the municipality does not want herbicide use, they will not use it.



Key Messages:

- Check with your local municipal office or Ministry of Natural Resources for burning restrictions or bylaws before burning grass or brush around your cottage.
- ✓ Build campfires on bare soil or exposed rock, well sheltered from the wind. Keep a pail of water and a shovel on hand to control the fire.
- ✓ Douse campfires with water and stir the ashes with a stick or shovel to allow the water to soak in and cool the ashes and the ground.
- ✓ Campfires should never be left unattended and must be thoroughly extinguished before leaving the site.
- Extinguish cigarette butts by dousing them with water or crushing them thoroughly in bare mineral soil or on bare rock.
- ✓ Never discard a burning cigarette in the bush or from the window of a moving vehicle.
- ✓ Allow portable generators, stoves and lanterns to cool before refuelling. Refuel on bare soil or exposed rock.
