Mike mentioned that there was no problem this year with the noise from the band. Everyone was happy with the layout of the vendors and band.

Jeannette will pull the BBQ tanks and get them filled at the trailer park. Darren will fix the dunk tank and get it on the new trailer. Steel from RO-Von for the dunk tank cost

\$180.00. Mike mentioned bringing two jacks to level the tank out. Julie said that at this time we are short 9 volunteers, but it usually works out in the end. Paula was asked to make signs for the booths in the event that there are no volunteer to man it. Paula was asked to phone Chris Coutu and ask for help with setup. Julie asked about getting new tents from Walmart. We would need the easy pop up ones. Elaine Carlson will be at the hall for 9:00 to organize the pie bakers. Paula will print two copies of the cotton candy machine manual for file. Mike will put bolts on the new peg boards. Debbie will do the balloons again this year.
