HILTON FAMILY FUN DAY

Tom Desjardin was present to give his opinion and ideas as to what could be done with the All-Season Sports Surface. Tom feels that there is a need for rink boards being put up for the winter rink season and feels that because there are no boards the rink cannot be utilized to its full capacity. He did some number crunching and found that it would cost approximately \$15,000.00 to get the rink board material purchased and we would need volunteer help to build them. Along with the cost of the boards there would also be the need to purchase ice scrappers and brooms to help with the clearing of the rink. Tom feels that the Township of Hilton would be willing to help out with these expenses since there are more from the Township that use the rink than from the Village. Tom said that Hilton Beach Recreation should look at running a spaghetti supper fundraiser or such to raise the money needed. Sally said that the summer people could try running a baseball tournament to also raise funds. Julie has offered to bring this idea to council. We would also need to find a volunteer that is will to keep the rink scraped and flooded twice a week. Paula offered to put up some posters and also put it on the Hilton Beach website. We would be looking at running our Hilton Family Fun Day on February 18, 2019. Tom will be doing one last cleanup on the rink before this event. Paula will contact Rod Woods and John Wells to see if they would be willing to run the games that day. Julie and Paula will be responsible for the food. We would like to see if the St. Joseph Island Voyageurs Club would be willing to provide snow machine rides for the children. We still have prizes left over from last year due to the fact that we could not have our Fun Day because of the warm weather and lack of volunteers for the rink upkeep. We will need to put it out there that we need volunteers to help out.

POTLUCK-APRIL 27, 2019

The name of the Potluck will be Spring Fling. We need to decide if this will be a themed event.

HILTON FAMILY YARD SALE-JUNE 22, 2019

Our fifth annual Hilton Family Yard Sale takes place on June 22, 2019. Julie and Paula will again be selling maps in front of the Hilton Beach Community Hall. Paula will take care of the advertising and the creation of the map. Julie and Darren have offered to pick up the signs at the end of the day.

Julie said that Community Night needs a separate committee with sub committees in order for it to run successfully. Julie will be bringing this to council.
