Heather mentioned having lots of ones, twos, fives and tens in the cash box. Julie mentioned increasing the cost of the pop next year. Mike will bring his trailer on Friday to help with the frozen yogurt machine and tables. We will need a separate cash box for the frozen yogurt. The frozen yogurt tent will be on the right of the BBQ tent facing Marks Street and the condiment table will be on the left of the BBQ tent.
