By-law Number 2017-19

"Being a By-law to Prohibit Outdoor Solid Fuel Combustion Compliances

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, Sections 8, 9 and 11, as amended, states that a local municipality may pass by-laws relating to the safety and well-being of the inhabitants of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 128, as amended, states that a local municipality may prohibit and regulate with respect to public nuisances, including matters that, in the opinion of Council, are or could become or cause public nuisances;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 129, as amended, states that a local municipality may prohibit and regulate with respect to noise, vibration, odour, dust and outdoor illumination;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 125, as amended states that a local municipality may regulate the use and installation of heating and cooking appliances;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Incorporated Village of Hilton Beach enacts as follows:

- 1. Definitions:
 - (a) "Outdoor solid fuel combustion appliance" (i.e. outdoor wood burning furnace) means a solid fuel burning appliance which is used for the space heating of buildings, the heating of water or other such purpose.
- 2. No person shall install or permit to be installed, any outdoor solid fuel combustion appliance within the Village of Hilton Beach.
