Municipalities have been legislated to develop and adopt a CSWB plan under the Police Services Act, 1990. The plan must include core information identifying local priority risks, strategies to address those priority risk factors and measurable outcomes.

This survey is being jointly undertaken by the **Townships of Hilton, Jocelyn, Johnson, Plummer Additional, St. Joseph, Tarbutt, Town of Bruce Mines and the Village of Hilton Beach** as well as various community partners, who together will form the Central Algoma Community Safety and Well-Being Committee.

The survey is meant to be completed by the residents of each municipality to help us understand their current state of well-being and feelings of safety so we can work together to focus on improving the quality of life for everyone.
