The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. Meeting was Chaired by Councillor Moore. Present were Councillors Moore, Bailey Meeks and Delvecchio.

Dale Kingsley, President, SJI Lions Club. Also present were Lions Club members Nelson, and Hendry

- 1. Use of the Community Hall during the winter months for Pancake Breakfasts and Meetings
 - The SJI Lions Club has requested that the Village keep the Community Hall open for the winter months to allow them to host Pancake Breakfasts the last Sunday of each month
 - Lions Club asked what they could contribute to allow this to happen
 - Councilor Moore confirmed that Council has previously decided to close the Hall for January, February and March, citing costs (heat, propane, and snow removal) as the reason for this decision. Council will reconsider if a suitable agreement is reached.
 - Lions also offer to pay a rental fee.
 - President Kingsley asked that Council get back to them with a price to rent the Hall including snow removal, and a price that does not include snow removal.
 - The back parking lot is required due to the attendance at the breakfasts so sanding of the parking lot is required.
 - Lions will also be providing the Municipality with a Certificate of Insurance for Commercial Liability.
 - It was agreed that the Lions Club can use the Council Chambers for their meetings during the winter months as long as these meetings do not conflict with Council Meetings
- 2. Use of the Community Hall for Christmas Craft Show December 12th, 2021
 - The Municipality cancelled the Holly Jolly Christmas Craft Show due to concerns over the ongoing COVID-19 crisis which affected the Recreation Committee, Museum Board and Library Board.
 - Councillor Bailey Meeks said it would be unfair to allow the Lions Club to host the event after making the decision to cancel a similar event. She cited the rising COVID-19 case counts in the region and concerns that these numbers will continue to rise as more restrictions are lifted.
