BY-LAW NO. 445 (18)
OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF HILTON BEACH BEING A
BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 432 OF THE SAID MUNICIPAL
CORPORATION.

WHEREAS the Municipal Corporation of Hilton Beach has heretofore enacted By-law 432 to regulate the use of land within the said municipal corporation,

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend the said by-law to establish the multi-unit residential complex for senior citizens heretofore existing in Hilton Beach as a permitted use in the Rural Zone of the said municipal corporation,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Hilton Beach enacts as follows:

By-law No. 432 of the said Corporation is amended by the addition to Section 4 - Zone R - Residential of the said by-law of a paragraph immediately following paragraph 4.1.8 on Page 9 of the said by-law to be known as paragraph 4.1.8a and to read as follows:

4.1.8a a multi-unit residential complex for senior citizens situate on part of Lot 1 and all of Lots 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Block D as shown on a plan registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Algoma as Plan No. 366 in the Village of Hilton Beach and composed of Part 2 according to a further plan registered in the said Registry Office as Plan IR 2420.

By-law 432 of the said Corporation is further amended by the addition to Schedule E of the said schedule of an additional item to be known as item 24 as follows:

The multi-unit residential 1 per residential complex for senior citizens unit in Hilton Beach

Read a first, second and third time and finally enacted this 11th day of August, 1980.
